SSE 7797: *Content and Program Analysis in Social Science Education* – Analysis of social science instructional programs including development of content, materials, processes, and assessment procedures in light of current research and practice. *Fall 2009, Fall 2011, Spring 2015, Spring 2017, Summer 2019, Spring 2020, Summer 2020*

Their expositions, explanations, and discussions focused upon possibilities of solutions may help students to understand traditional and modern problems of epistemology and theories of knowledge. *Spring 2015*

EME 2040: *Introduction to Educational Technology* - Introduction to microcomputer technology and its function in the classroom to augment the teaching and learning processes. *Spring 2004*
