Consent Agenda Content Confirmation was voted on and approved.

Committee Action Agenda:

The Anthropology Department presented ANT 2410 as a GEP course to the committee and it was approved.

Changes to the Nonprofit Management Minor and Health Sciences programs were presented by COHPA and approved by the committee. Deletion of the Nonprofit Management Certificate was also approved.

International Business Certificate, International Business Minor, Human Resources Certificate, Entrepreneurship Certificate and Management B.S.B.A were tabled and will be presented by COBA at the February meeting. COBA got approval, pending amendments to the changes proposed, for the Economics B.S. and Business Economics B.S.B.A. programs. The statement located in the Departmental Exit Requirements section: "Students are required to pass an exit survey and comprehensive exit exam in Economics." must be changed to, "Students are required to complete an exit survey and comprehensive exit exam in Economics." (The department chair will provide the necessary documents for this change.)

COS's programs (Terrorism Studies Minor, Social Sciences B.S., Sociology B.S. and Anthropology) were approved.

CEDHP requested for all of their programs on the agenda (Teacher Education B.S.-Art Education, Elementary Education B.S.-Elementary Education B.S. Lifelong Learning Track, Secondary Education B.S.-English Language Arts Education Track/English Language Art Lifelong Learning Track, Secondary Education B.S.-Mathematics Ed Track/Mathematics Lifelong Learning Track, Secondary Education B.S.-Science Education Chemistry Track/Chemistry Lifelong Learning Track, Secondary Education B.S.-Science Biology Track/Biology Lifelong Learning Track, Secondary Education B.S.-Science Education Physics Track/Physics Lifelong Learning Track, and Secondary Education B.S.- Social Science Education Track/Social Science Lifelong Learning Track) to be taken as a group and they were all approved.
