External microphone for recording narration: ideally you record the narration with a microphone that is external to your recording device. This means you plug in a mic that you can direct rather than relying on the terrible mic that is built into your phone or computer.

Amazon has literally hundreds of these mics, starting at \$5 and up. I like one that has a cord so it can be put on a stand. You don't want to hold the mic or lay it down so it's not aimed at the source or where something blocks the mic head.
