- h. Consideration of GEP courses this Fall term
 - There are no proposals currently submitted in Kuali. Any new proposals, if approved, would take effect in Academic Year 2027-2028.
 - ii. The proposal for modern languages courses to be included in the GEP is under evaluation by the state.
 - 1. If approved, changes could take effect in the Fall 2026 term, as modern languages was previously approved for another Florida institution.
 - If other courses are offered at another Florida institution, proposals could potentially be approved for Fall 2026. GURC would need to review them before the end of the calendar year.
- i. Selection of Foundation for Course Reviews
 - The committee agreed to establish procedures and/or special committees for course reviews this semester and conduct reviews next semester.
