HB 999 and impact to GEP:

- Wayne Bowen reviewed how HB 999 would affect the GEP.
- Advised, the committee shouldn't approve any additional courses until we see what is approved by the state.
- Likely changes to the statewide General Education Program include:
 - Requirement that these courses:
 - Be only lower level

- Be offered as GEP at more than 50% of SUS and FCS institutions.
- Comply with revised criteria in each of the five Foundation areas.
- Be reviewed each year by the Board of Governors

Discussion of PEM 2104, Personal Fitness and Wellness for GEP designation:

- Dr. David Fukuda and Dr. Alison Redd (Division of Kinesiology) proposed PEM 2104 to be a part of GEP designation, specifically in the Social Foundation.
